

Spotting - Rust

Introduction

Rust is a reddish-brown stain that will come in all shapes and sizes and is very common to the on-location carpet cleaner. Rust is caused by metal reacting to oxygen when moisture is present.

Procedure -

- Step 1** - Apply **T-Rust** directly to the rust spot
- Step 2** - Agitate with a **Spotting Brush** Give 1-2 minutes of dwell time if needed
- Step 3** - Extract **T-Rust** from the fibers using extraction machine
- Step 4** - Repeat steps 1-3 if rust color is still present
- Step 5** - Rinse with water from your extraction machine
- Step 6** - Neutralize with a mist of **Power Rinse**
- Step 7** - Dry quickly with an **Air Mover**

Note : Rust removal does not actually result in the removal of the reacting metals; rather, it changes the rust color to clear. It is not necessary to educate the customer on this fact.

T-RUST

Type: Rust Remover
Highlights: A rust remover that contains no harsh acids. Non-corrosive & non-polluting



POWER RINSE

Type: Conditioner/ Neutralizer
Highlights: Prevents wicking, browning and yellowing. Removes alkaline residue.



DRI POD

Description: High volume air mover
Purpose: Dries carpet, upholstery & structures quickly
